In a city where we are constantly surrounded by movements, sights, and sounds, we often tend to focus not on our surroundings, but on ourself. There is an endless saturation of visual information on every street corner and with every building and it is inevitable, at some point, we become immune to the commotion and in turn, the beauty.

By focusing on his surrounding, artist David Leonard opens our eyes to New York City. His views are not those of a single individual, but from a collective view as one of millions. Leonard takes the confusion and abstraction of the city and creates a recognizable and comprehendible scene, one in which we can clearly see for miles down a crowded avenue without the blurred elements of our daily lives.

"One of the parallels I find interesting is, like life itself, there's always so much going on all around us here. It's hard to comprehend everything but, as I hope you can see, it's easier to in a painting," states the artist.

By expanding the field of view, Leonard includes details of the city that are often overlooked, from the manhole covers up to the spire of the Empire State Building. I want the view to focus on the whole picture as opposed to the individuals in it. It's not about a particular person's experience, but a collective memory of the city."

David Leonard received his BFAfrom Rochester Institute of Technology in 1985 and has also studied at the Banff Centre for the Fine Arts in Banff, Alberta, Canada. He currently resides in Austin, TX.

The George Billis Gallery marks its fourteenth year in the Chelsea art district and recently opened a second gallery in the burgeoning art district of Culver City in Los Angeles.
